

Ponderings

A rather significant meeting took place between two world leaders recently. Not much of the meeting was covered in the press. The meeting took place in Rome between Pope Francis and Pope Tawadros II. Two popes? Pope Tawadros is the leader of the Coptic Christians. Based in Egypt the Coptic Orthodox Church, also known as the Coptic Orthodox Patriarchate of Alexandria, is an Eastern Orthodox Church which, in addition to serving the faithful in Egypt, also has a strong presence in Africa and the Middle East. Christians in Egypt make up an estimated 10% of the country's population of 109 million, and of those, the vast majority are Coptic Orthodox. They constitute not only the largest population of Christians in Egypt, but in the Middle East as a whole.

The first ever meeting between a Catholic pope and a Coptic Orthodox patriarch of Egypt took place in 1973 when Pope Paul VI and Coptic Pope Shenouda III signed a historic Christological declaration, initiating a bilateral ecumenical dialogue between the two churches that continues to this day. In a joint declaration signed by Paul VI and Shenouda III, several shared beliefs between the two churches were highlighted, including faith in Jesus as full God and full man, the seven sacraments, veneration of the Virgin Mary and the saints, the church as founded by the apostles and the importance of ecumenism.

A second meeting between a pope and Coptic Patriarch took place when Shenouda III met with Pope John Paul II in Cairo in February 2000. The most recent meeting, forty years after the 1973 meeting, was held May 10, 2013, when the newly elected Pope Francis met with the also newly elected Pope Tawadros II in Rome.

Coptic Christians in Egypt and the Middle East have often been the victims of violent persecution against the Christian community and Pope Francis has repeatedly sent messages to Tawadros voicing sorrow and sympathy. Perhaps the most gruesome example was the horrifying video released by the Islamic State group in 2015, which showed militants beheading 21 men dressed in orange prison jumpsuits and wearing handcuffs. Of the 21 men killed on that occasion, 20 were Coptic Christians and one was a Ghanaian Christian, all of whom prayed to Jesus as they were killed.

In his meeting with Pope Tawadros, our Holy Father, Pope Francis said that these 21 men, “were baptized not only in water and the Spirit, but also in blood, a blood that is the seed of unity for all followers of Christ.” He then announced that the 21 men “will be included in the Roman Martyrology as a sign of spiritual communion that unites our two churches.” The Martyrology of the Catholic Church is considered a liturgical book and is used for the praying of the daily office, meaning the Copts can now be recalled in official Catholic prayers.

Pope Francis, though not calling for it directly, has repeatedly indicated his desire for a common Christian martyrology, often saying there is an ‘ecumenism of blood’ among those killed in violent Christian persecution regardless of what rite or church they belong to.” He said of these 21 men killed by ISIS, they are men “who kept the faith and bore witness to Christ, who did not lose heart in the face of torture, and who have passed onto us a living example in martyrdom.”

Sometimes, the ‘wheels of ecumenism’ spin slowly----and yet, there are glimmers of hope-----such as the meeting between Pope Francis and Pope Tawadros. They are united by the blood of the martyrs-----which has brought unity to believers since the earliest days of the Church.

Women's Retreat


